



South Wirdleonia: South of the Border

As we all know, the rapid spillover from Schulmanidad into the Plains of Wirdleonia has taken place at a record pace. The trail south from Schulmanidad's North Coast Highway leads directly to the ferry port, making colonization a cinch for explorers and developers.



This crucial intersection just over the border is where the explorers branched out to survey the massive plains. And, developed, it serves as the crossroads for the first suburb in Schulmania: South Schulmanidad.

With the establishment of the first settlement, the new Colony of South Wirdleonia has been proclaimed. Princess Katherine has been appointed to be Colonial Governor, vacating her seat as

So, let's explore this crossroads suburb just across the border in newly-explored South Wirdleonia.



The North Coast Highway now extends across the Atkinos border, forming the first land district-to-district connection in Schulmania. In South Schulmanidad, the highway keeps its name until it reaches the crossroads. South of it, it is mostly unpaved and known as the Southlands Trail.



A wider view of the border area shows extensive residential development. The demand for housing is very high, but developers cannot keep pace at all. There is little commerce or industry- most residents work in Schulmanidad and commute.



South of the crossroads, the North Coast Highway to Schulmanidad becomes the Southlands Trail, which is paved for only a short distance before becoming dirt trail into the wilderness.

There are a few large agricultural areas in town, mainly to the south and east.



Hacienda Fajitas Con Carne provides fresh food for many residents and anchors the east side fo town.



Just to the east, at the edge of town, on unpaved Tabakky Road, is Mama's Place.

On the west side, residential development provides a great starting place for colonists heading south.
